"I've never walked into a 24-Hour Mart and seen anything truly unique. But that's exactly what you see every time you walk out your front door," Tom says. "Now our relationship with nature is at a critical threshold. If you blink, it may be gone. But when the shutter blinks," Tom pantomimes with a forefinger and thumb, "ch-chcht," he says, "it's frozen in time forever. To see the world in a grain of film..."
